### **SITUATION REPORT**

**06/11/2009 1100 hrs**

A line of severe thunderstorms moved through Laclede County on the evening of June 10<sup>th</sup>. The storms caused numerous damages due to wind.

#### **PUBLIC SAFETY**

Laclede County Fire Departments have completed searches of damaged/destroyed residences and outbuildings and all persons are accounted for at this time. One injury was reported when a tree fell through the roof of the home of a Red Cross volunteer and struck her in the head. She was taken to a local hospital, and released this morning.

#### **PUBLIC WORKS**

Laclede Electric Co-Op peaked with approximately 5,000 outages during the height of the storm, and is currently below 100 outages. The City of Lebanon reported 350 outages, and all have been restored except for 2; which have damage to the electrical services of the residences.

#### **DAMAGE ASSESSMENT**

At this time, estimated 3 homes with major damage and 12 with minor damage. In addition, several barns & outbuildings have been damaged or destroyed. One motel in Lebanon is reporting moderate roof damage; and several business are reporting minor damage to their buildings

#### **HUMAN SERVICES**

The Laclede County Chapter of the American Red Cross is working to meet the immediate needs of those affected by the severe weather event by providing lodging and other emergency needs. The Red Cross has opened 1 case at this time.

#### **EOC OPERATIONS**

The EOC has returned to normal operations; and is on standby.
